THE 2026 BERNINA GRID BEGINS TO TAKE SHAPE

First selections confirmed as media accreditation opens for Bernina Gran Turismo 2026. Accredited media are invited to an exclusive Media Preview Day at the Kulm Country Club on 11 September ahead of the public race weekend on 12–13 September.

St. Moritz / Poschiavo, June 2026 – Bernina Gran Turismo returns to the Bernina Pass on 12–13 September 2026. Media accreditation is now officially open for journalists, photographers and content creators wishing to cover one of Europe's most distinctive historic hillclimbs.

On Friday, 11 September, accredited media will be invited to a dedicated Media Preview Day at the scenic setting of the Kulm Country Club in St. Moritz, offering an opportunity to discover selected cars, meet participants and experience the atmosphere of Bernina Gran Turismo before the public race weekend begins.

A Hillclimb Built for Drivers

Unlike many classic automotive gatherings centred around display, Bernina Gran Turismo remains focused on driving. Historic competition and sports cars are brought together between La Rösa and Ospizio Bernina, where altitude, weather and the mountain road itself define the challenge.

With its unique setting on the Bernina Pass, the event continues to attract a diverse community of racing drivers, owners, restorers, collectors and enthusiasts from across Europe, united by a shared passion for preserving, maintaining and driving exceptional cars in the environment for which they were built.

Three Categories, One Mountain Road

Bernina Gran Turismo offers three distinct categories, each reflecting a different approach to historic motoring and competition.

The Competition category is dedicated to drivers seeking outright performance on the 5.7-kilometre hillclimb between La Rösa and Ospizio Bernina.

The Regularity category rewards consistency rather than speed, challenging competitors to reproduce target times with the highest possible precision.

The Demo category provides a platform for significant historic, competition and modern performance cars to experience the Bernina Pass outside of competition.

First Cars Confirmed

Among the cars making their Bernina Gran Turismo debut are the 1968 Chevron B8 GT, 1955 Ferrari 250 GT, 1965 Ferrari 275 GTB Alloy, 1975 Datsun 280Z, 1950 Healey Westland C, 1931

Riley TT Sprite, 1982 Renault 5 Turbo, 1947 Stanguellini 1100 Coupé Motto, 1965 Alfa Romeo Giulia TZ1 and the 1974 Lancia Stratos Group 4.

Returning to the Bernina Pass are the 1932 Alfa Romeo 8C 2300, the 1965 Alfa Romeo Giulia TZ2, the 1954 Maserati A6GCS/53 and the 1966 Shelby Cobra 427 S/C.

To preserve the character of the event, the field will once again remain limited to a maximum of 70 carefully selected cars.

The 2026 edition also welcomes Bovensiepen as Official Partner, further strengthening Bernina Gran Turismo's connection to craftsmanship, engineering excellence and automotive individuality.
