FOR A FEW DAYS EACH SEPTEMBER, THE BERNINA PASS BECOMES A PLACE OF GATHERING

Media accreditation is now open, including access to an exclusive Media Preview Day at the scenic Kulm Country Club in St. Moritz on 11 September ahead of the public race weekend on 12–13 September.

St. Moritz / Poschiavo, June 2026 – St. Moritz / Poschiavo, June 2026 – Few automotive events combine exceptional cars, dramatic landscapes and alpine hospitality quite like Bernina Gran Turismo. Set against the backdrop of the Bernina Pass, the event returns on 12–13 September 2026, bringing together collectors, enthusiasts and travellers from across Europe for a weekend shaped by movement, scenery and character.

For a few days each September, one of Switzerland's most spectacular mountain roads becomes the setting for a unique gathering where historic automobiles are experienced not as museum pieces, but in motion, exactly as they were intended.

A Weekend Defined by the a Mountain Pass

Unlike traditional automotive events centred around a circuit or exhibition ground, Bernina Gran Turismo unfolds across one of the most spectacular mountain roads in Europe.

Throughout the weekend, participants and spectators move between the Engadin and Valposchiavo, following the rhythm of the event as it unfolds across the Bernina Pass. The experience is shaped as much by the landscape as by the cars themselves.

The Bernina Pass becomes the stage. Historic automobiles are not displayed behind ropes or confined to paddocks, but experienced in motion against a backdrop of glaciers, mountain lakes and dramatic alpine scenery.

For many visitors, it is the combination of exceptional cars, remarkable scenery and the unique atmosphere of the Bernina region that makes Bernina Gran Turismo unlike any other automotive event.

From La Rösa to Ospizio Bernina

The Bernina experience begins at La Rösa, the historic starting point of the hillclimb and former post station where travellers once paused before crossing the pass.

Long before the arrival of automobiles, La Rösa served as an important stopping point along the historic Bernina route, offering rest and shelter to travellers, merchants and horse-drawn carriages making their way through the high Alps.

New for 2026, visitors at La Rösa will be able to follow the action via a dedicated viewing screen while experiencing the atmosphere of the race start.

Further up the mountain, the BGT Village at Ospizio Bernina serves as the social heart of the weekend. Open to the public throughout the event, it brings together participants, visitors, hospitality partners and regional producers against the dramatic backdrop of the Bernina landscape.

Rough Luxury on the Bernina Pass

At the heart of Bernina Gran Turismo lies a philosophy the organisers describe as Rough Luxury. Not luxury defined by excess, but by authenticity, craftsmanship and character. The event remains intentionally restrained in scale, preserving the atmosphere that has made it one of the Alps' most distinctive gatherings for collectors, enthusiasts and travellers alike.

The event's collaboration with St. Moritz Tourism further strengthens its connection to one of the Alps' most iconic destinations. This is complemented by the partnership with Suvretta House, one of St. Moritz's most celebrated grand hotels and a longstanding symbol of the region's hospitality tradition.
