BERNINA GRAN TURISMO STRENGTHENS THE CONNECTION BETWEEN ENGADIN AND VALPOSCHIAVO

Media accreditation is now open. Accredited journalists are invited to a Media Preview Day at the Kulm Country Club on 11 September before the public event on 12–13 September.

St. Moritz / Poschiavo, June 2026 – Bernina Gran Turismo returns on 12–13 September 2026, continuing its role as a unique platform connecting the Engadin and Valposchiavo through heritage, tourism and a shared Alpine landscape.

On Friday, 11 September, accredited media will be invited to a dedicated Media Preview Day at the scenic setting of the Kulm Country Club in St. Moritz, providing an opportunity to meet organisers, partners and participants ahead of the public race weekend.

Inspired by the historic Bernina races of 1929 and 1930, Bernina Gran Turismo has evolved into much more than a motorsport event. Today it brings together local institutions, municipalities, tourism organisations, hospitality providers, businesses and volunteers from both sides of the Bernina Pass.

A Project Built Across Two Valleys

Each September, the temporary closure of the Bernina road between La Rösa and Ospizio Bernina transforms a public mountain pass into a motorsport venue. This is only possible through close collaboration between local communities, cantonal authorities, emergency services, tourism partners and residents throughout the Engadin and Valposchiavo.

Far from being a disruption, this collaboration has become one of the defining characteristics of the event. Bernina Gran Turismo is not staged within the region, it is created together with the region.

A Public Gathering

Beyond the competition itself, Bernina Gran Turismo continues to develop the BGT Village at Ospizio Bernina as a central meeting point for participants, spectators and regional partners.

Open and accessible to all, the event invites locals, visitors and automotive enthusiasts alike to experience the Bernina Pass in a unique way, whether following the competition, exploring the region or simply enjoying the atmosphere.

New for 2026, La Rösa will become an additional gathering point for visitors. From the historic former post station and starting point of the hillclimb, guests will be able to follow the action via a dedicated live viewing screen while enjoying local food and beverage offerings and experiencing the unique atmosphere of the race start.

Throughout the race weekend, both the BGT Village at Ospizio Bernina and La Rōsa offer opportunities to experience the event through hospitality, regional food and beverage offerings, partner activations and unique viewpoints along the Bernina Pass.

Extending the Event's International Reach

In addition to attracting visitors and media to the region, Bernina Gran Turismo will once again be livestreamed worldwide via [YouTube](#) and [Swiss Sport TV](#), further strengthening the event's international visibility and allowing audiences across the globe to follow the action live from the Bernina Pass.

Commitment Beyond the Race Weekend

Bernina Gran Turismo is part of the Swiss tourism sustainability programme Swisustainable and currently holds Level I – Committed status.

Current initiatives include:

- Development of a carbon accounting framework
- Exploration of synthetic fuel solutions
- Waste reduction measures
- Increased use of public transport for participants and guests
- Greater integration of local suppliers and hospitality partners
- Ongoing dialogue with regional stakeholders regarding environmental and social impact

The objective is not simply to reduce impact, but to ensure that the event evolves in a way that remains compatible with the landscape and communities that make it possible.
